Starting this season, we will limit the number of passes sold per day.

To optimize crowd levels within the ski area, reduce lift times, and provide more attentive service, we will be introducing a daily sales limit. Our goal is to offer a safer and higher-quality skiing experience while preserving the surrounding natural environment. Lift passes are valid only on the date of purchase, so please select your planned visit date from the calendar when making your purchase.

Daily Sales Limit: 1,200 passes per day

Guests staying at the adjacent Rockwood Hotel & Spa, as well as holders of season passes or various advance-purchase tickets, are not subject to this entry limit.

Riding in the "At Your Own Risk Area"

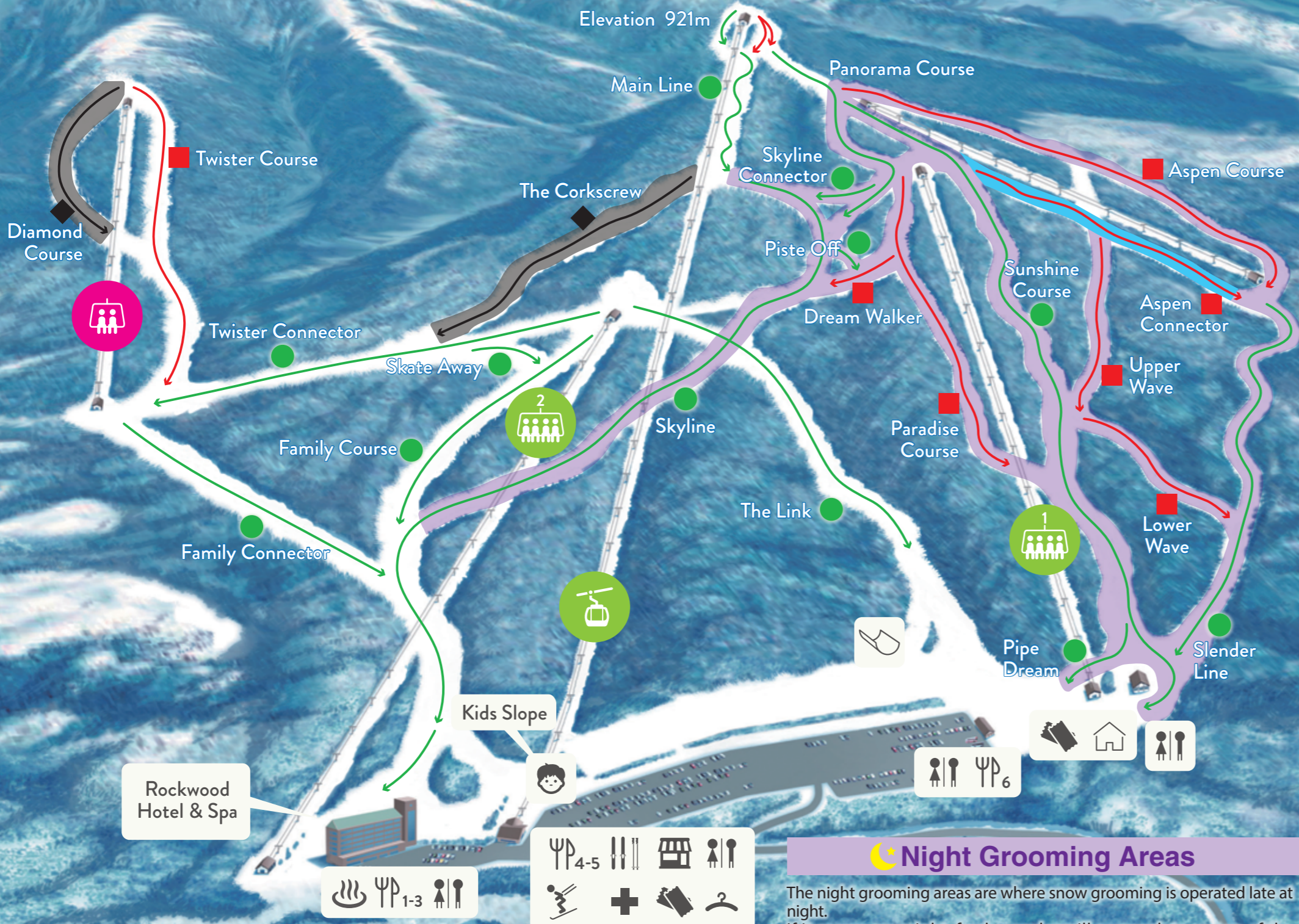
The self-responsibility area/hike-up course is outside the course. The boundary between the ski resort course and the outside of the course is defined by fences, ropes, poles, and remaining forest (clumps of trees).

■ Risk is not managed by the resort in "At Your Own Risk Area"

■ In "At Your Own Risk Area" There are various unexpected hazards such as avalanche terrain, rocks, cliffs, trees, stumps, artificial structures, avalanche debris and sudden changes in snow condition. Also search and rescue operations if available may be delayed

■ Patrol services are not provided outside designated ski courses.

■ If an incident occurs in an "At Your Own Risk Area" and ski patrol is required to conduct search and rescue operations, Aomori Spring Ski Resort will charge the actual rescue costs to the individual involved.
